

# EVANSTON GOLF COURSE IN SHAPE FOR PUBLIC PLAY

## Nine Hole Links Will Be Opened Tomorrow; Ad- dition Later.

Evanston, one of the local cradles of golf, has finally obtained a public course, which will be opened tomorrow. It has been established through the efforts of the Evanston Community Recreation association, which by mutual agreement with the Northmoor club has been able to secure nine holes on the property formerly occupied by the Evanston club.

Dressing rooms for men and women have been provided through the kindness of the street car company, which will permit the use of its barns on Central street.

### Northmoor to Move.

The Northmoor club, which has temporary leases on the property it occupies, will later move to a new course near Ravinia, and the recreation association officials hope eventually to have eighteen holes by taking in some property south of Central street, and later to get another eighteen hole course by utilizing some Wilmette property.
